



After six successful conferences, the **Seventh World Congress on Polyphenols Applications** was held in Bonn, Germany, on June 6-7, 2013.

Prof. Dr. Marvin Edeas, Chairman of ISANH, and **Prof. Dr. Andreas Schieber**, Chairman of the Scientific Committee, welcomed the participants.

Bonn Polyphenols 2013, financially supported by **Neckermann Group** (Germany) featured an interesting blend of scientific and cultural activities.

In his introductory keynote lecture, **Prof. Dr. Francisco Tomás-Barberán** (Spain) highlighted the importance of polyphenols in human health.

The subsequent scientific sessions included a review of UHPLC as a tool for polyphenol analysis by **Dr. Bernd Zimmermann** (University of Bonn, Germany) and a seminar on polyphenols in food by **Prof. Dr. Chryswig Franz** (University of Bonn, Germany).
